Natural Resource Coordinator: Brad discussed the Davis Gulch lower bicycle obstacle course that Prickly Pear Land Trust approved for the riders to construct. There have been conflicts with the trail right next to the course. There was discussion on how the original upper course came to exist and which is now not being used. The June meeting will include a visit to the area, and the Gravity Guild group will be invited. Brad said with the construction of the bike park at Centennial Park the current jumps should go away. The Daisy Hill route has been rerouted. There is also a new trail off LeGrande Cannon Boulevard to the left. A couple of trails have also been closed and some rerouted with mostly volunteer labor. There was discussion about moving a trail that is adjacent to the back of some houses. There was extensive discussion about dogs being off a leash at the trailheads rather than 100 yards from the trailhead. His summer crew starts soon.
