Dear Helena Area Transit Service (HATS) Customer,

We are happy to announce our new HATS ADA Para Transit Identification Cards. These cards will allow ADA Para Transit passengers to ride the fixed route for a reduced fare. The card also extends the riders ADA eligibility until 12/31/2017.

Additionally we also have 3 new passes available for our customers.

In August of this year, the Helena City Commission signed a resolution supporting **no increase in fares**, and changing the bus passes for easier use by the passengers.

10 ride punch card \$ 8.00  
20 ride punch card \$15.00  
30 ride punch card \$21.00

\*Punch cards can be purchased from the HATS office, or the Bus Driver. The Bus drivers do not carry change. \*

In addition, the Helena City Commission enacted a reduced fare of \$0.50 (fifty cents) per ride for ADA Para Transit passengers using the fixed route buses. In order to take advantage of the reduced fare, you must show your enclosed HATS ADA Para Transit Identification Card.

\* Please refer to the bus schedule for fixed route locations\*.

East Valley ADA Para Transit Passengers; In order to take advantage of the reduced fare, you must be at an East Valley Fixed Route Bus Stop, and show your enclosed HATS ADA Para Transit Identification Card. The reduced fare cannot be used for ADA Para Transit Origin to Destination requests. \* Please refer to the bus schedule for fixed route locations\*.

These changes will be in effect starting January 04, 2016. We will accept any existing old bus passes until all are used up.
