Waste	Disposal Options
Adhesives, Contact Cements, Roofing Tar	If Solid put in trash, if liquid, harden and put in trash.
Alkaline Batteries	Throw in Trash/Batteries Plus (Fee)
Antifreeze	City of Helena Transfer Station – 447-8082; 5 gallons or less
Appliances	Transfer Station/Pacific Steel- 442-7851
Asbestos	Lewis and Clark Landfill – 457-8521
Building Material	Transfer Station or Lewis and Clark Landfill – 457-8521
Car Batteries	City of Helena Transfer Station - 447-8082 opt. 3
CFL Bulbs	Lowes, Home Depot (no tubes)
Chlorinated Solvents	HHW Event
Electronic Waste	City of Helena Transfer Station – 447-8082 opt. 3
Explosives – Flares, Fuses ,Fireworks, Gunpowder and Ammunition	City of Helena Assistant Police Chief Steve Hagen – 447-8487 Lewis and Clark County Sheriff's Department – 447-8204
Fluorescent Tube Bulbs	Batteries Plus - 442-2623 (fee for 4 – 8 ft. tubes) Household Hazardous Waste – tubes up to 6 ft.
Fuel	City of Helena Transfer Station; one gallon or less
Gas Cylinders	Oxygen should have yellow label with company who owns tank All other gases most likely General Distributing – 442-7737
Latex Paint	Give to someone, Solidify by adding an absorbent such as cat litter or paint a board. Once solid dispose of in the pit at Transfer Station. Twice yearly there is a paint exchange for usable Latex paint at The Transfer Station
Motor Oil	City of Helena Transfer Station – 447-8082; 5 gallons or less.
Medication	Law Enforcement Center (Lobby) 221 Breckenridge
Oil based paint	Give to someone, solidify very small amounts as described above or bring to Hazardous Waste Event
PCB's or PCB Ballasts	HHW Event
Pesticides/Herbicides	Give to someone who can use it, HHW Event
Rechargeable Batteries	Lowes, Home Depot, Batteries Plus, E-waste area at Transfer Station
Spray Paint	Give to someone who can use it; empty cans can be thrown in garbage, If unable to empty, bring to HHW Event
Strong Acids (Nitric, Hydrochloric, Sulfuric)	HHW Event
Syringes	Collect in a Sharps approved container and dispose of at Transfer Station
Tires	Transfer Station – 447-8082
Thinners/Non Chlorinated Solvents/ Mineral Spirits	Give to someone if good, HHW Event
