

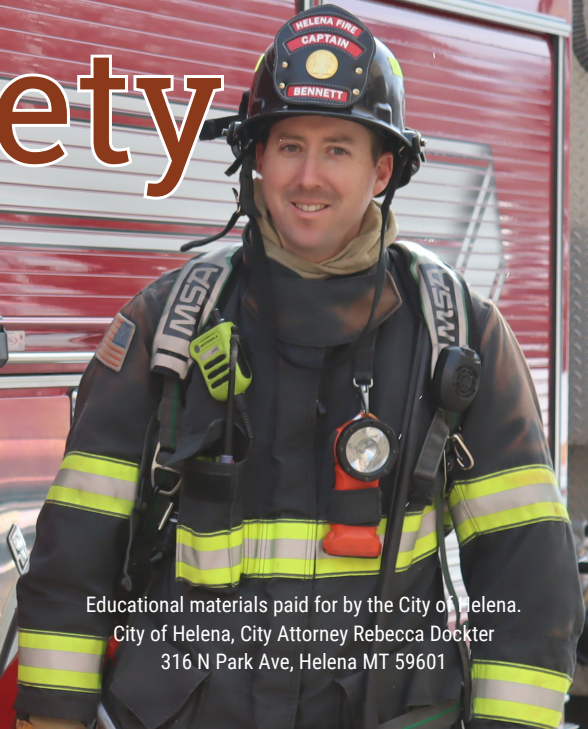

A Bond is proposed for construction of a new Fire Station.

- ▶ The Fire Department doesn't have a station North of the train tracks.

A Mill Levy is proposed to add Police Department staff and Firefighters.

- ▶ Fire Department calls for service have increased 892% since the second station was opened in 1979.
- ▶ The Police Department's Patrol Division hasn't increased staffing in 20 years.
