#### What is on the June 4 Ballot?

Mill Levy (Personnel)

31.66 mills (Permanent)

Covers salaries, benefits, and equipment

#### General Obligation Bond (New Fire Station & Training Facility)

5.66 mills per year (20-year debt)

Covers the debt service for the new facility and equipment

### Why is this needed?

It has been 45 years since the City opened its second fire station, and 20 years since Police added Patrol staff.

#### **Growth Facts**

- City limits have grown approximately 3 miles over the past 20 years.
- The City's daytime population is estimated 44,500.

## What will it cost taxpayers?

If both the Mill Levy and Bond are approved, the taxes on a home valued at \$300,000 would increase:\*\*

\$151.13 per year \$12.59 per month \$0.41

## **How is Public Safety Funded?**

Public Safety is primarily funded through the City's General Fund (Property Tax Revenue).

## **Funding Facts**

- The City's General Fund receives approximately 20% of property taxes.
- Cities and Counties can only increase property tax revenue by 1/2 the rate of inflation, over a 3-year average.
- City of Helena's property tax collections only increased 3.4% from 2013-2022.\*\*\*
