## **RESOLUTION NO. 20060**

### **A RESOLUTION DECLARING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF THAT PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Helena owns four parking meters that are no longer needed for use by the City of Helena at present or in the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that these parking meters be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager.

**WHEREAS**, the Holter Museum of Art has offered to accept four parking meters so that they may be decorated by local artists and potentially placed in locations throughout the city for purposes of soliciting donations;

**WHEREAS**, public art is essential for creating a vibrant community; and

**WHEREAS**, people using our city attractions choose to contribute to and support these features.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:**

**Section 1.** Four parking meters are hereby declared surplus property, and the City Manager is authorized to dispose of it as allowed by Section 1-4-18 of the Helena City Code.
