## **RESOLUTION NO. 20321**

### **A RESOLUTION DECLARING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF THAT PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Helena owns Parade 1 (vehicle #122) and Engine 2 (vehicle #129), both used and operated by the Helena Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, these vehicles are no longer needed for use by the City of Helena at present or in the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS**, Parade 1 is no longer in a useable or safe condition and while Engine 2 is useable, the manufacturer of Engine 2 is no longer in business, making the purchase of parts and maintenance of that vehicle untenable; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Helena has recently acquired two new engines to replace the abovementioned vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that the vehicles be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:**

**Section 1.** The personal property described above is hereby declared surplus property, and the City Manager, pursuant to section 1-4-18(C) of the Helena City Code, is authorized dispose of
