## ORDINANCE NO. 3235

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5  
OF THE HELENA CITY CODE TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENTS TO HOLD  
UNCLAIMED PROPERTY IN THE POSSESSION OF THE HELENA POLICE DEPARTMENT  
FOR 6 MONTHS AND TO HOLD AN AUCTION TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY  
OF HELENA, MONTANA:

That Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Helena City Code is hereby  
repealed in its entirety and is reserved.

### Chapter 5

#### ~~SALE OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY~~

~~**5-5-1: AUCTION SALE OF PROPERTY:** All personal property in possession  
of the police department, and unclaimed by the owner thereof for a  
period of six (6) months, may be sold by the chief of police at public  
auction, for cash, to the highest bidder. (1979 Code)~~

~~**5-5-2: NOTICE OF SALE:** Notice of sale, specifying the property to  
be sold, date and place of sale, shall be published in at least one  
publication of a newspaper published in said city and said date of  
sale shall be not less than ten (10) days from the first publication  
(or in the case of only one publication, then from date of  
publication) and not more than fifteen (15) days from such  
publication. (1979 Code)~~
