ORDINANCE NO. 3239

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE 2 OF THE HELENA CITY CODE TO REPEAL THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD AND ESTABLISH A POLICE COMMISSION

That Chapter 7 of Title 2 of the Helena City Code is hereby amended by repealing it in its entirety and inserting the following language in lieu thereof:

CHAPTER 7

POLICE COMMISSION

SECTION:

- 2-7- 1: CREATED; APPOINTEES
- 2-7- 2: POLICE COMMISSION DUTIES

2-7-1: CREATED; APPOINTEES:

- A. There is hereby created a police commission for the city, to consist of members appointed in accordance with §7-32-4151, MCA.
- B. The terms and compensation of members of the police commission are as found in §7-32-4152, MCA.

2-7-2: POLICE COMMISSION DUTIES:

- A. The police commission shall administer such portions of title 7, chapter 32, part 41, Montana Code Annotated, as are not inconsistent herewith.
- B. The board shall examine all applicants certified for the police force forwarded to it by the Helena Police Department as to their age, legal, mental, moral, and physical qualifications. (Ord.
