## A RESOLUTION DECLARING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF THAT PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, the City of Helena owns two (2) items of weight training equipment previously used by the Helena Police Department (HPD), described as a Smith Machine and a Pro Spot P100 Cable Guide Machine; and

**WHEREAS**, both items are no longer used by the HPD due to the fact that they are currently inoperable and cannot be repaired; and

**WHEREAS**, these items are no longer needed for use by the City of Helena at present or in the foreseeable future and are a liability to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 1-4-18 of the Helena City Code identifies various means for disposition of surplus personal property; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and its inhabitants that the weight training equipment be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:**

**Section 1.** The two (2) items of weight training equipment described above are hereby declared surplus property, and the
