RESOLUTION NO. 20438

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 2013 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO DONATE THE VEHICLE TO THE STATE OF MONTANA

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns a 2013 Ford Police Interceptor, Unit #51, VIN #1FM5K8AR8DGA38547;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 20435, this vehicle was previously declared surplus property on March 26, 2018, and disposal by the City Manager was authorized through consignment to a surplus property public auction;

WHEREAS, this vehicle is no longer needed for use by the City of Helena at present or in the foreseeable future;

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark Juvenile Probation and Parole is in need of an all-wheel drive vehicle;

WHEREAS, the Helena Police Department proposes to donate the vehicle to Lewis and Clark Juvenile Probation and Parole rather than sell the vehicle through public auction; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that the vehicle described above be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager pursuant to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The vehicle described above is hereby declared surplus property and the City Manager, pursuant to Section 1-4-18(C) of the Helena City Code, is authorized to dispose of it by transfer to the State of Montana, Office of Court Administrator, First Judicial District Youth Court Services.

Section 2. The previous authorization, pursuant to Resolution No. 20435, to dispose of the vehicle through consignment to a surplus property public auction is null and void.
