A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE 2002 HURST EXTRICATION EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO DONATE THE EQUIPMENT TO THE LEWIS AND CLARK RURAL FIRE COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns a 2002 Hurst Extrication equipment;

WHEREAS, this equipment is no longer needed for use by the City of Helena Fire Department at present or in the foreseeable future;

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark Rural Fire Council is in need of extrication equipment;

WHEREAS, the Helena Fire Department proposes to donate the 2002 Hurst extrication equipment to Lewis and Clark Rural Fire Council pursuant to Section 1-4-18(D)(3); and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that the equipment described above, be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager pursuant to this resolution.
