## RESOLUTION NO. 20452

### A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO APPROVE THE WORK PLAN AND BUDGET FOR THE TOURISM BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 19644, passed April 20, 2009 created a tourism business improvement district ("District") to promote tourism, conventions, trade shows, and travel to the city;

**WHEREAS**, the Helena City Commission expanded the District on August 22, 2011, by Resolution No. 19871;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §7-12-1132, MCA, the Board of Trustees for the District must present to the City Commission a work plan and budget for ensuing fiscal year;

**WHEREAS**, a work plan and budget for fiscal year 2019 was submitted to the Helena City Commission by the Board of Trustees for the District on May 16, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to defray the costs of the work plan and budget, it is necessary for the City of Helena to levy an assessment on all property within the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:**

**Section 1.** That it is the intention of the Helena City Commission to approve the work plan and budget, as submitted by the District and levy an assessment upon all property within the

District for fiscal year 2019 to defray the costs of said work plan and budget. The assessment for fiscal year 2019 on all lodging facilities used for providing overnight stays within the District is proposed to be computed by multiplying the number of rooms occupied from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 for each lodging facility within the District, as reported by the District, by one dollar (\$1.00).

**Section 2.** That the Commission of the City of Helena, Montana, will be in session in the Commission Chambers at the City-County Administration Building, 316 N. Park Ave., in Helena, MT, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. for a public hearing at which time and place the Commission will hear objections to the proposed fiscal year 2019 work plan and budget of the District and levy. Said work plan and budget are on file with the Clerk of the City Commission and interested persons are free to inspect and copy the same.

**Section 3.** Notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention shall be given by publishing as required by §7-12-4177 and §7-1-4127, MCA. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to make publication of this Resolution of Intention in the Independent Record, the official newspaper of the City of Helena.
