RESOLUTION NO. 20502

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE BILL ROBERTS MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE FOR THE 2019 SEASON

WHEREAS, the Bill Roberts Municipal Golf Course Advisory Board recommended changes in the charges imposed upon users of the golf course for the 2019 golf season; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the implementation of fees for the 2019 season was held on November 19, 2018, in the Commission Chambers in the City-County Building at 316 North Park Avenue in Helena Montana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. That the Helena City Commission hereby establishes the following fees for the 2019 season as suggested by the Bill Roberts Municipal Golf Course Advisory Board:

REFUNDS: No refunds will be given for lost or stolen punch cards or season passes.

Refunds for unused portions of punch cards or season passes may be granted by the City Manager, upon certification from a licensed physician that the holder's medical condition prevents the holder from being able to participate in golf for the remainder of the season. If a refund is granted, the refund will be pro-rated, less the number of documented played rounds based on the current green fee value. No refunds will be considered after August 1st.

Passes and punch cards will not be extended to the next season. Punch cards are transferrable, but are only good for one golf season.

Rain checks may be issued for lost rounds of play due to course conditions that pose a threat to the safety of the golfers or due to an imminent medical emergency of a golfer. Rain check refunds will not be issued after 5 holes of completed golf for 9 holes of play and 13 holes of completed golf for 18 holes of play.

DONATIONS: The City Manager may authorize the Bill Roberts Golf Course golf professional to donate up to 35 rounds of "2 for 1" free golf per golf season to promote the Bill Roberts Golf Course at charitable events.

The City Manager may authorize the Bill Roberts Golf Course golf professional to donate up to \$1,000 of pro shop merchandise valued at retail value for charitable purposes per golf season.

Based on professional courtesy and golf course practices throughout the industry, the City Manager may authorize the issuance of complimentary golf privileges to visiting golf professionals and visiting golf course superintendants.

PROMOTIONS: The City Manager may authorize the Bill Roberts Golf course professional to implement promotional programs that result in discounted rates for the purpose of increasing under-utilized course play times. Promotions may include "loyalty member" programs, 2 for 1 specials, etc.

Section 2. The following definitions apply:

"Couple" is two adults who cohabit and share a single household.

"Senior" is a person 65 years of age or older.

"Young adult" is a person who is between the ages of 19 and 29.

"Junior" is a person who is eighteen years old or younger.

"Active Military" is a person who is on full-time duty in the active military service of the United States. This includes members of the reserve components serving on active duty or full-time training duty, but does not include full-time National Guard duty.
