RESOLUTION NO. 20514

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE BLUE CARD COMMAND TRAINING SYSTEM OWNED BY THE CITY OF HELENA TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO DONATE THE EQUIPMENT TO THE MONTANA STATE FIRE SERVICES TRAINING SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns a Blue Card Command training system that was originally purchased in 2013 for \$12,500, with a Montana Disaster and Emergency Services grant;

WHEREAS, this training system is no longer needed for use by the City of Helena Fire Department at present or in the foreseeable future;

WHEREAS, the Montana State Fire Services Training School has use for the training system;

WHEREAS, the Helena Fire Department proposes to donate the Blue Card Command training system to the Montana State Fire Services Training School pursuant to Section 1-4-18(D)(3); and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that the equipment described above, be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager pursuant to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The Blue Card Command training system described above is hereby declared surplus property and the City Manager, pursuant to Section 1-4-18(C) of the Helena City Code, is authorized to dispose of it by transfer to the Montana State Fire Services Training School in exchange for two (2) Fire Officer I academy training credits valued at \$2,180.00.
