RESOLUTION NO. 20557

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WORK PLAN AND BUDGET FOR THE TOURISM BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND LEVYING AN ASSESSMENT ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 19644, passed April 20, 2009, created a Tourism Business Improvement District ("District") to promote tourism, conventions, trade shows, and travel to the City;

WHEREAS, the City Commission expanded the District on August 22, 2011, by Resolution No. 19871;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20473, passed August 27, 2018, re-created the District for another ten (10) year period;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-12-1132, MCA, the Board of Trustees for the District must present to the City Commission a work plan and budget for the ensuing fiscal year;

WHEREAS, a work plan and budget for fiscal year 2020 was submitted to the Helena City Commission by the Board of Trustees for the District on May 11, 2019;

WHEREAS, in order to defray the costs of the work plan and budget, it is necessary for the City of Helena to levy an assessment on all property within the District; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this resolution was held by the City Commission on August 26, 2019, in the City Commission

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The City Commission approves the work plan and budget, as submitted by the District and attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and levies an assessment upon all property within the District for the fiscal year 2020 to defray the cost of said work plan and budget. The assessment for fiscal year 2020 on all lodging facilities used for providing overnight stays within the District is computed by multiplying the number of rooms occupied from July 1, 2018, through September 30, 2018, for each lodging facility within the District, as reported by the District, by one dollar (\$1.00) and from October 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, for each lodging facility within the District, as reported by the District, by two dollars (\$2.00).
