RESOLUTION NO. 20610

A RESOLUTION DECLARING POLICE K-9 "DINO" TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP TO JOHN KALECZYC

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns police dog known as K-9 "Dino" which was purchased for approximately \$14,000, inclusive of required training;

WHEREAS, K-9 "Dino" is 8 years old and nearing the end of his professional career and older police dogs do not transition well to a new handler;

WHEREAS, K-9 "Dino" is no longer needed for use by the City of Helena at present or in the foreseeable future;

WHEREAS, the Helena Police Department proposes to donate K-9 "Dino" to his handler former Officer John Kaleczyc;

WHEREAS; Section 1-4-18(C) of the Helena City Code, requires City Commission approval to dispose of personal property owned by the City of Helena with an original value of more than five thousand dollars; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that the dog be declared surplus and disposed of by the City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:
