RESOLUTION NO. 20616

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 5258 THAT CREATED SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 192 BY REMOVING TWO LIGHTS IN THE ALLEY BEHIND 102 AND 128 SOUTH BENTON AND ONE STREET LIGHT IN FRONT OF 138 JEFFERSON STREET, IN THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA

WHEREAS, Section 7-12-4354, MCA, allows the City of Helena to remove street lights in a special improvement street lighting district by resolution if the minor modification reduces the assessments within the maintenance district;

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1954, the City Commission passed Resolution No. 5258 that created Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192 in the City of Helena;

WHEREAS, on August 5, 1987, the City Commission passed Resolution No. 9972 that expanded the boundaries of City of Helena Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192;

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, the City Commission passed Resolution No. 20227 that removed one light in the alley behind 110 South Benton Avenue;

WHEREAS, several property owners within Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192 have petitioned the City for removal of three lights, two lights in the alley behind 102 and 128 South Benton and one street light in the front of 138 Jefferson;

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena, and the inhabitants thereof, specifically the inhabitants of Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192, that Resolution No. 5258 be further amended to remove three lights, two lights in the alley behind 102 and 128 South Benton Avenue and one street light in the front of 138 Jefferson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The Commission of the City of Helena, Montana hereby further amends Resolution No. 5258 that created Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192 in the City of Helena by removing three lights, two lights in the alley behind 102 and 128 South Benton Avenue and one street light in the front of 138 Jefferson.

Section 2. There are fifty (50) lights in Special Improvement Street Lighting District No. 192 and it is estimated that removing three lights will save the entire district approximately \$277.08 in annual costs.
