RESOLUTION NO. 20619

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO SET FEES CHARGED FOR USE OF THE HELENA CIVIC CENTER AND REPEAL RESOLUTION NO. 20353

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns and operates a facility known as the Civic Center;

WHEREAS, the City of Helena, in the prudent management of its financial affairs, must charge fees for the use of the Civic Center that support the cost of operating said facility;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20353, passed July 10, 2017, previously established fees for the use of the Civic Center;

WHEREAS, staff has recommended modifying the fees currently charged for the use of the Helena Civic Center to update fees and to accommodate limited uses due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena, Montana, and the inhabitants thereof, that the Helena City Commission hold a public hearing on said proposed fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Helena City Commission to set fees charged for use of the Civic Center as shown on the attached Exhibit "A."
