RESOLUTION NO. 20626

A RESOLUTION TO SET FEES CHARGED FOR USE OF THE HELENA CIVIC CENTER AND REPEAL RESOLUTION NO. 20353

WHEREAS, the City of Helena owns and operates a facility known as the Civic Center;

WHEREAS, the City of Helena, in the prudent management of its financial affairs, must charge fees for the use of the Civic Center that support the cost of operating said facility;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20353, passed July 10, 2017, previously set the fees charged for the use of the Civic Center;

WHEREAS, A public hearing on setting the fees charged for the use of the Helena Civic Center was held on September 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena, Montana, and the inhabitants thereof, that the Helena City Commission set the fees charged for the use of the Helena Civic Center to accommodate limited uses due to COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. That the Helena City Commission hereby sets the fees charged for use of the Civic Center as shown on the attached Exhibit "A."
