A RESOLUTION GRANTING A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF RESOLUTION NO. 20606

WHEREAS, on June 8th, 2020, by Resolution No. 20606, the Helena City Commission conditionally approved vacating the full width of 6th Avenue right-of-way between North Roberts Street and Sanders Street and Blocks 4 and 9 of the Corbin Subdivision in the City of Helena, County of Lewis and Clark, Montana, in order to accommodate the construction of a new Montana Heritage Center; and
