

RESOLUTIONS OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA

RESOLUTION NO. 20695

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 20595 THAT DECLARED A STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the Mayor declared a state of local disaster emergency for ten (10) days due to the imminent threat of widespread loss of life resulting from COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the City Commission passed Resolution No. 20595 declaring a state of local disaster emergency indefinitely continuing the Declaration;

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to repeal Resolution No. 20595 and subsequent amendments reflected in Resolution Nos. 20599, 20612, and 20648.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. Resolution No. 20595 and subsequent amendments reflected in Resolutions No. 20599, 20612, and 20648 are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Copies of this Resolution will be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, the Clerk of the City Commission, and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.

Section 3. The public shall be notified as soon as reasonably feasible through general dissemination to the news

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media, posting on the city website and social media accounts, or using other means of communication appropriate for informing the general public.
