

RESOLUTIONS OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA

RESOLUTION NO. 20375

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CITIZEN CONSERVATION BOARD FOR THE CITY OF HELENA

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Helena City Charter, the Helena City Commission may establish various committees to foster and promote the general quality of life with the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20347 called for the establishment of a Citizen Conservation Board to support, recommend, report on, and monitor sustainability measures undertaken by the City of Helena.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The Citizen Conservation Board is hereby established and shall be comprised of the following individuals, each of whom must be citizens of the City of Helena:

One (1) representative from the Helena Citizen's Council;

Two (2) representatives from the Watershed or Water Conservation sector;

Two (2) representatives from environmental organizations;

Two (2) representatives from the business or building industries;

One (1) health care professional;

One (1) professional engineer;

One (1) educator in the earth sciences field;

Two (2) citizens at large; and

Two (2) student leaders.

Section 2. This board will be staffed and assigned as directed by the City Manager.

Section 3. This board will support, recommend, report on, and monitor sustainability measures undertaken by the City of Helena.

Section 4. This board shall, within three (3) months of the appointment of all members, establish rules and policies for the internal operation of the board.

Section 5. This resolution will sunset and this board will be eliminated sixty (60) months from and after its first meeting date unless specifically extended by resolution of the Helena City Commission.
