ORDINANCE NO. 3178

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 5 OF THE HELENA CITY CODE TO CLARIFY THE ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

That Chapter 2 of Title 5 of the Helena City Code is hereby

amended as follows:

5-2-1: **DEFINITIONS, GENERAL**: The following words and terms as used in this chapter shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them:

ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER: All duly appointed and qualified deputies, as well as the duly appointed and qualified city animal control officer.

AT LARGE: Off the premises of the owner and not under the immediate, continuous and effective control of its owner or some other competent person.

ENCLOSURE: <u>A vehicle, pen, cage, kennel or</u> <u>other similar object surrounded on</u> <u>all sides sufficient to prevent an</u> animal from escaping.

RESTRAINT:

Controlled by a leash, at "heel" beside a competent person and obedient to that person's command, within a vehicle with permission of the owner, or within the property limits of the premises controlled by the owner or other person consenting thereto.

WILD ANIMAL: Any animal which is not a domesticated animal. (Ord. 2193, 8-10-1981- amd. Ord. 2488, 1-23-1989; amd. Ord. 3123, 7-12-2010; amd. Ord. 3178, 6-24-2013.

5-2-2 through 5-2-13: No change.

5-2-14: ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE: No animal shall be allowed to run at large within the corporate limits of the city. Any person who owns, harbors or keeps an animal, or the parent or guardian of any such person under the age of eighteen (18) years, shall be is strictly liable for any violation of this section. All animals not confined within an enclosure or on the owner's property shall <u>must</u> be kept on a leash not more than ten feet (10') long that is physically held by a responsible person, securely restrained, or <u>must be securely</u> held <u>by a responsible</u> person so as to prevent the animal from running at large, with the following exceptions: All dogs must be kept under control, either on a leash or within sight and under voice control of their owners or other <u>competent responsible</u> persons when they are within any "natural park" as defined in section 7-12-1 of this code and as designated by the city commission- or within a

fenced area of a dog park as designated by the city commission. Dogs must be kept on a leash <u>as described above</u> within one hundred (100) yards of any trailhead in <u>to</u> any natural park. (Ord. 3023, 4-11-2005; amd. Ord. 3178, 6-24-2013)

5-2-15: ANIMALS DEEMED A NUISANCE:

- A. It is a public nuisance <u>unlawful for any person to own</u>, <u>harbor</u>, <u>keep</u>, or <u>maintain</u> for any dog or other animal to chase vehicles in public streets, ways or parks; to <u>that</u> cause<u>s</u> annoyance to any person by prolonged barking, howling, yelping, or other means; to run at large; or to be owned, kept or maintained without a current license. All female dogs or other animals in heat (estrus) shall be kept in a confined area <u>or enclosure</u> not accessible to male animals<u>which may be running at large</u>.
- B. Any such nuisance animal may be taken up and impounded by the animal control officer or any law enforcement officer. It is unlawful for any person to own, harbor, keep or maintain any such nuisance animal, and it shall be the duty of the animal control officer and all law enforcement officers to issue tickets and file complaints for all such violations. Any person aggrieved by a nuisance may file a

complaint in the municipal court, charging the owner with the violation of this section. (Ord. 3121, 1-11-2010, eff. 3-1-2010; amd. Ord. 3178, 6-24-2013)

5-2-16: No change.

5-2-17: CONFINEMENT OF CERTAIN ANIMALS: Every female dog or cat in heat shall be confined in a building or secure enclosure or in a veterinary hospital or boarding kennel, in such manner that such female dog or cat cannot attract another animal, except for breeding purposes. No wild animal may be kept within the city limits, except under such conditions as shall be fixed by the city, provided, however, that wild animals may be kept for exhibition purposes by circuses, zoos and educational institutions in accordance with such regulations as shall be established by the city. Any animal as described herein found at large shall be impounded by the animal control officer and may not be redeemed by the owner unless such redemption is authorized by the animal control officer.
