RESOLUTION NO. 20511

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 5261 THAT
CREATED SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 193 TO ADD TWO
(2) LIGHTS IN THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA**

WHEREAS, §7-12-4301, et seq., MCA, allows the City of Helena to create and alter the boundaries of special improvement lighting districts;

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1954, the City Commission considered and passed Resolution No. 5261 that created Special Improvement Lighting District No. 193 in the City of Helena;

WHEREAS, Special Improvement Lighting District No. 193 roughly encompasses an area around Thirteenth Street, Fourteenth Street, and Front Street;

WHEREAS, Project No. ST5907 will reconstruct Front Street and street lights will need to be replaced;

WHEREAS, Northwestern Energy's replacement of the existing high-pressure sodium lights with light-emitting diode lights requires two (2) additional lights to be installed to provide the same coverage;

WHEREAS, §7-12-4354, MCA, allows the City of Helena to add lights to the district if the increases in the average assessments within the maintenance district will be less than

3% in a fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the addition of the two lights will decrease the average assessments within the district by thirty-nine dollars (\$39) or four percent (4%);

WHEREAS, the City of Helena will pay for the costs of installation related to the additional two (2) lights; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena, and the inhabitants thereof, specifically the inhabitants of Special Improvement Lighting District No. 193 that Special Improvement Lighting District No. 193 be amended to add two (2) additional lights as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The Commission of the City of Helena, Montana hereby amends Resolution No. 5261 that created Special Improvement Lighting District No. 193 in the City of Helena by adding two (2) additional lights as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Section 2. There is total of nine (9) lights in this district and it is estimated that converting the existing lights to light-emitting diode lights and adding two (2) additional light-emitting diode lights will save the entire district approximately thirty-nine dollars (\$39) in annual electrical costs.
