RESOLUTION NO. 19731

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HELENA TO APPLY FOR A MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE CDBG PUBLIC FACILITIES GRANT TO ASSIST INTERMOUNTAIN IN DEVELOPING COTTAGES FOR ITS RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Helena wishes to make an application to the Montana Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to assist Intermountain with funds for construction of new cottages for its residential treatment program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Helena has conducted two public hearings in conformance with CDBG requirements to obtain the views of citizens on community development and residential treatment needs for children, and on the activity proposed here; and

WHEREAS, the City of Helena has the legal jurisdiction and authority to assist Intermountain in the financing of the cottages through the proceeds of the CDBG public facilities grant; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the City of Helena and the inhabitants thereof that an application be made for a CDBG grant to construct new cottages for Intermountain's residential treatment program; and

WHEREAS, Intermountain commits to providing the matching funds as proposed in the CDBG application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. The City of Helena agrees to conform with the regulations, statutes, terms, and conditions described in the CDBG Certification for Application attached hereto.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Helena is hereby authorized to submit an application to the Montana Department of Commerce on behalf of the City of Helena for a CDBG Public Facilities Grant to construct three cottages for residential treatment, to act on behalf of the City of Helena, and to provide such additional information as may be required.
