## A Resolution of the

## Helena Citizens' Council to support passenger rail service through Helena, MT

A resolution of the Citizens' Council of Helena, Montana, in support of reestablishing passenger rail service through Helena connecting to other population centers of Montana.

**Whereas,** AMTRAK's Empire Builder is the number one long distance passenger train in the United States, and is greatly needed for the citizens of Montana's Hi-Line who do not have a great choice of public transportation in a large rural state like Montana; and

**Whereas,** AMTRAK discontinued service along its southern Hiawatha route in 1979, leaving only the Empire Builder to provide passenger rail service to Montana for the past 37 years; and

Whereas, Montanans living along the abandoned Hiawatha route must, as a consequence, drive for three to five hours to get to the nearest train station; and

**Whereas**, transportation to and from the major population centers of southern Montana would be greatly enhanced by passenger rail service; and

Whereas, improved passenger rail service connecting the major population centers of southern Montana to each other and perhaps beyond would constitute a boon to tourism and the economy of the region; and

**Whereas**, we are facing a critical problem with global warming and we need to greatly reduce our emissions of greenhouse gases into the atmosphere; and

**Whereas,** Montana's southern Hiawatha rail route now by-passes Butte to include Helena;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, the Helena Citizens' Council hereby recommends to the Helena City Commission that they support any effort -- be it AMTRAK, government sponsored, or private -- to reestablish passenger rail service along the present BNSF/Montana Rail Link route connecting Helena with its sister cities across southern Montana. The Helena Citizens' Council further recommends a cooperative relationship with the freight railroads and passenger operations.

Passed and adopted this <u>28th</u> day of the month of <u>September</u>, in the year of <u>2016</u> by a majority vote of the <u>Helena Citizens</u>' Council.
