RESOLUTION NO. 20357

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ADJUST RATES FOR ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF HELENA WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, water system users are charged a base rate and a per unit rate for water consumption as required by §6-2-8 of the Helena City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Helena City Commission last adjusted water rates in November of 2016; and

WHEREAS, rate adjustments are necessary to adjust for inflation of costs of service, provide for necessary capital improvements, and meet bonded debt coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Helena City Commission desires to encourage water conservation by decreasing the per unit charge for residential customers using 0-8 units of water per month; and

WHEREAS, commercial uses and residential uses that consume more than 8 units of water per month place a larger demand for waste residential uses using less than 8 units per month and therefore should pay a higher rate for water.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HELENA, MONTANA:

Section 1. It is the intention of the Helena City Commission to consider adjusting water base and usage rates imposed upon all water customers.

Section 2. The new proposed rates are shown below:
