**Instructions:**

Helena's growth may take many forms, depending on factors both in and out of local control. City policy can play a key role, but only if it reflects the values of folks that live and work here. For this four-part exercise, tell us:

1. On the "Existing" scale, tell us how well you think Helena already performs for each of ten character features. What's Helena's current status or reputation?
2. On the "Envisioned" scale, tell us how well you'd like the community to perform in the future - how critical to you think each factor ought to be in realizing the city's greatest potential?
3. Comparing your existing and envisioned scores for each factor, calculate the **total gap** between them - for instance, scores of 2 and 8 should equal a gap of 6.
4. Finally, tell us how much of an investment in resources Helena ought to make to support each factor. Using a "budget" of 10, allocate among the categories as you'd craft a growth strategy. Make note of your resource expenditures in the "Weight" column, and total them below. Remember not to exceed 10 units!

Make notes as needed to explain your scoring. We've provided an "Other" category to fill in too - and though we won't include fill-ins in tallies today, they will be reviewed as part of the results. **Thanks!**
