The City of Helena Solid Waste – Recycling Division will be holding a Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off on Saturday, October 1, 2022 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. City of Helena and Scratch gravel residential permits will be required the day of the event.

Many unwanted hazardous and toxic materials are accepted at this event.

Items Accepted:

- *Aluminum paints
- *Oil-based paints and stains
- *Paint Thinner
- *De-greasers
- *Flammable liquids
- *Aerosol paints
- *Fluorescent tubes
- *Mercury thermometers & Thermostats
- *Acids and Bases - (Sulfuric acid & Hydrochloric acid)
- *Bleach
- *Cleaning agents

- *Ammonia water
- *Sodium hydroxide
- *Pesticides & poisons
- *Oxidizers
- *Reactives
- *PCB Ballasts

Items NOT Accepted:

- *Explosives (ammo, gun powder, blasting materials)
- *Latex Paint
- *Empty Paint & Aerosol Cans
- *Radioactive Materials
