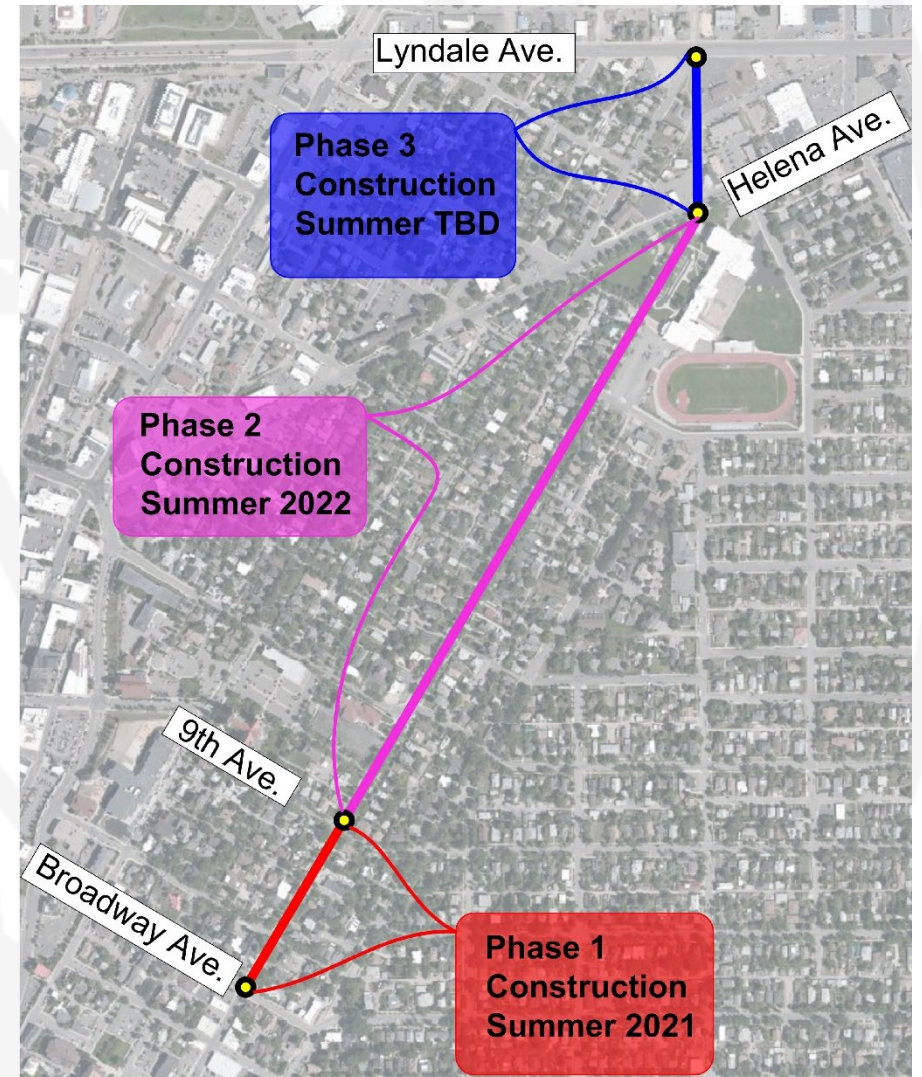

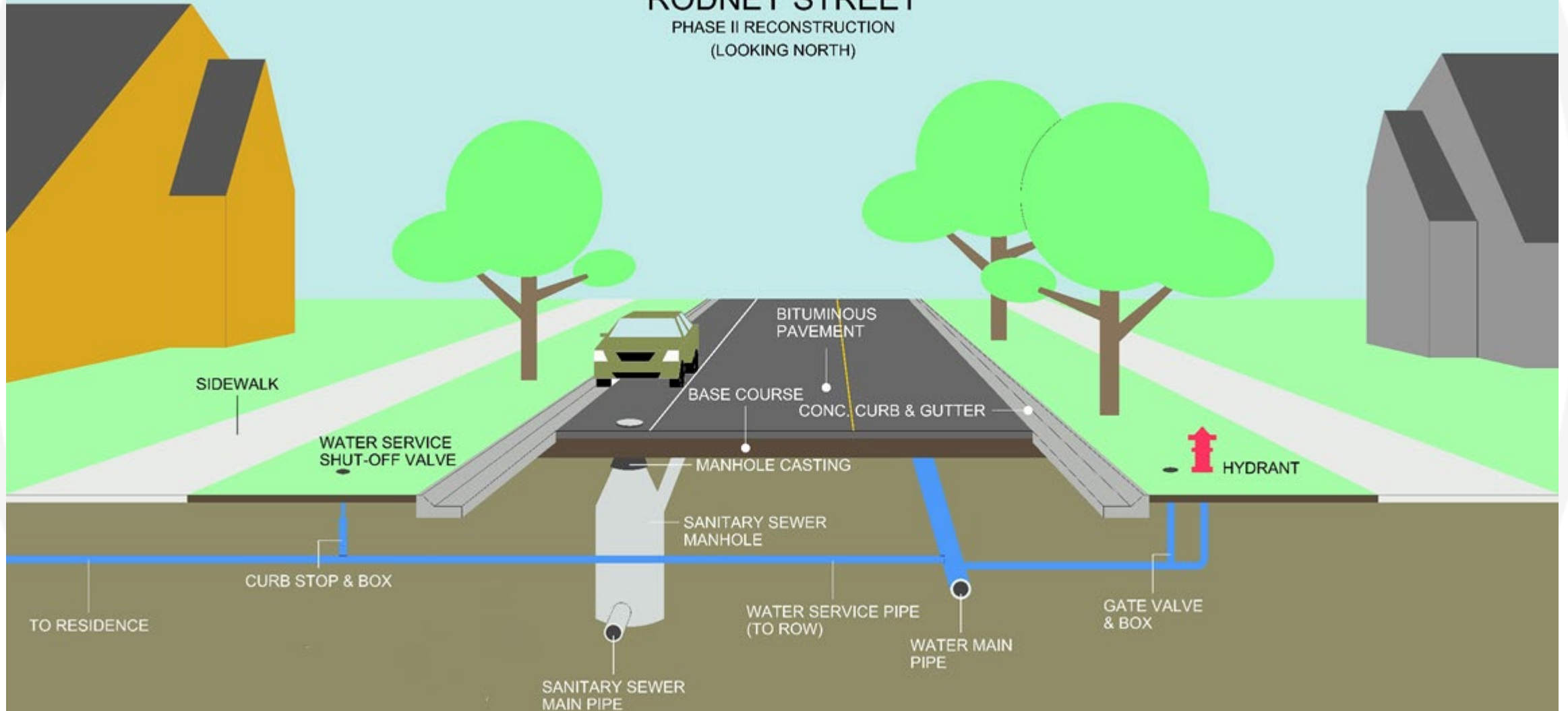
Project Structure: Phased Approach

- **Phase 1** - Broadway to 9th Avenue (construction complete)
Status: Construction to start this year
- **Phase 2** - 9th Avenue to Helena Avenue
Status: Construction has began
- **Phase 3** - : Helena Avenue to Lyndale Avenue and Broadway to Division Street. (TBD)

Construction Schedule

- **300 day contract with Notice to Proceed Late June 2022**
- **Expect to see up to 3-4 blocks closed at a time. Access will be maintained but may be limited to residences with efforts made to minimize access disruption as much as feasible.**
- **Water should have minimal service disruption and if temporary water is needed, residences will be contacted prior.**
- **Plan is to have the portion in front of Helena Middle School to be open back up to traffic before school starts.**
- **Work in the intersection of 11th is likely going to be next construction season. You may see some activity there prior to get ready for the work.**



Construction Schedule

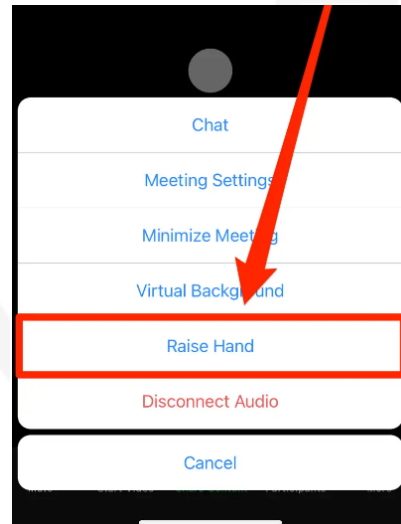
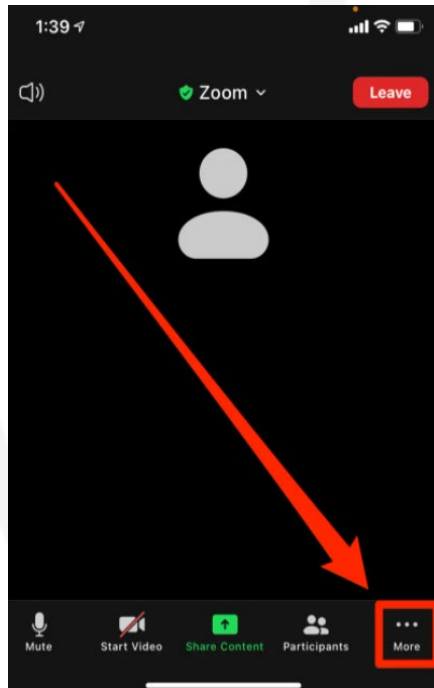
- Irrigation impacts will be coordinated with landowner
- Gas lines have already been relocated in some areas and the gas company will coordinate as necessary as they continue with their relocation
- Garbage and Recycling will be coordinated with landowners when they are affected to make sure they are taken to side streets as needed for pickup
- Know that there will be construction activities in front of your house at some point and to be aware of trucks and equipment if you are in your yard and to avoid interactions with equipment as safety of everybody is our number 1 concern.
