


KNOW YOUR SNOW RESPONSIBILITY

IN HELENA, WHEN THE SNOW FALLS, THE AMOUNTS CAN VARY MAKING IT **DIFFICULT FOR PEDESTRIANS TO** WALK SAFELY ON THE SIDEWALKS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

KNOWING YOUR RESPONSIBILITY FOR CLEARING OR REMOVING SNOW WILL MAKE FOR A SAFE WINTER SEASON FOR ALL OF HELENA



STREETS



City Streets and Roadways are the responsibility of the Transportation Systems Dept. They are cleared in the ALLEYS



Alleys are generally not plowed by the City because of the narrow pathways.

- following order:
- 1. Emergency Snow Routes
- 2. Priority Routes
- 3. Local Streets

When necessary for garbage collection, the Solid Waste Division may plow all or part of an alley.

DRIVEWAYS



Driveways and personal walkways, including a driveway apron that must be crossed for pedestrian travel, are the responsibility of the homeowner.

Please be aware that relocating snow from your driveway or walkway into the **Right-Of-Way is prohibited.**

SIDEWALKS



Every owner of a property, fronting on or abutting a paved or brick sidewalk on public rights of way, must remove and clear away any snow or ice from:

sidewalks in front of or abutting their property

all portions of abutting ADA curb ramps and bulb outs

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

All vehicles must be removed from streets designated as **Emergency Snow Routes when 2**" or more of snowfall is forecasted

No campers, trailers, or other stored items may be parked on City streets or Rights-of-Way between Nov 1st and April 15th
